Modernization of IT tools for the implementation of tasks related to supporting criminal analysis

Project title: Modernization of IT tools for the implementation of tasks related to supporting criminal analysis.

Project value: The total value of the project is PLN 2 112 180,00, including co-financing from the European Union's Internal Security Fund for 2021-2027 (75%) – PLN 1 584 135,00 and national budget funds (25%) – PLN 528 045,00.

Grant Agreement: Financial Agreement No. FBWP.01.01-IZ.00-0003/25, concluded on April 2, 2026.

Project implementation period: from January 1, 2026 to December 31, 2027.

Project Activities:

Activity No. 1-5 – It includes equipping the Internal Security Agency with specialized IT and technical infrastructure intended for criminal analysis, including the purchase of workstations, monitors, database and analytical software, and large-format printers.

Project Objective: The objective of the project is to increase the effectiveness of the Internal Security Agency in detecting and combating crime, including international and cross-border **crime**, by modernizing hardware and software to enable efficient processing and analysis of large datasets.

Project result: Increasing the capacity to process and analyze data collected and processed as part of tasks carried out by the Internal Security Agency, including cases with an international scope, which will enable more effective use of analytical results within bilateral and multilateral cooperation in combating international crime.
